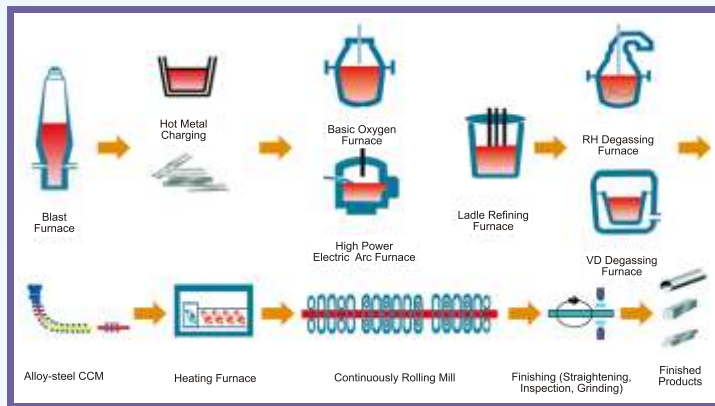

## ■ Indian Special Steels Sector



As an extremely important sector in the iron & steel industry, Special Steels segment produces variety of steels such as Carbon Steels, Spring Steels, Free Cutting Steels, Heat Resistant Steels, Tool and Die Steels, High Speed Steels, micro alloyed steels etc. using alloy additions such as chromium, manganese, vanadium, silicon, lead etc. Typically, the producers of such grades are mini steel plants having EAF, refining facilities, concast and hi-tech rolling mills and are situated all over the country. Nevertheless, few of the integrated plants also produce special steels but are limited in number. It is estimated that the special steels segment grew by around 13 % annually in the last decade. 'Steelworld' research reveals that among various user industries, the auto and auto ancillary sector plays major role in the growth for special steels with a share of around 50 % of its total demand. All major global automakers have entered into Indian market and have set up or are in the process of setting up their production facilities here.

The objective is not only to cater to Indian markets but to develop a global production hub. Their requirement for steel is also changing in terms of quantity and quality. They require more intricate grades with stricter composition, closer tolerances and enhanced mechanical properties. It is surely a big challenge in front of special steel makers to cope up with the growing demands from the user industries. Presently, auto market seems to be depressed and this has put tremendous back pressure on the special steels producers and auto component industry. The other applications of special steels include power sector, aerospace, defense, engineering etc. where the demand seems to be rising steadily. Considering the growth and consumption potential of Special Steels and the development of auto and other engineering industries in the country, the Special Steels demand will continue to grow, but at a slower rate of around 7% till 2016-17. The total consumption of Special Steels is expected to be around 8.7Mt for 2016-17.



## ■ The Conference



The 7th edition of 'Special Steels Convention' is being organised for the professionals and technocrats from the entire special steels sector. The convention topics will encompass the full supply and process chain right from raw materials like scrap, sponge iron, ferro alloys to the finished products like forgings, bright bars, springs, fasteners, etc. The one day conference will emphasize on issues such as special steels melting and casting, latest technologies at various stages, new applications and emerging markets for special steels and its products, end user's perspective, etc. The conference will also debate other prime issues facing this industry like fluctuations in raw material as well as steel prices, slump in export markets, import threats, high power cost, threat from other materials like composites etc.
